# The State of the Church

### 2 Corinthians 5:17-20 Message

Now we look inside, and what we see is that anyone united with the Messiah gets a fresh start, is created new. <u>The old life is gone</u>; <u>a new life emerges! Look at it!</u> All this comes from the God who settled the relationship between us and him, and then called us to settle our relationships with each other. God put the world square with himself through the Messiah, giving the world a fresh start by offering forgiveness of sins. <u>God has given us the task of telling</u> <u>everyone what he is doing. We're Christ's representatives</u>. God <u>uses us to persuade men and women to drop their differences and</u> <u>enter into God's work of making things right between them</u>. We're speaking for Christ himself now: Become friends with God; he's already a friend with you.

### **Introductory Statement**

The church is God's instrument to deliver the message of transformation to our communities and to the world. You will discover in the Bible that God's favor rests on the church, and communities. When God transforms lives, He does not just build temples of the Holy Spirit in the individuals, He builds His church by adding more lives to the body.

### Let's take a look....

U.S. church membership was **73%** when Gallup first measured it in <u>1937</u> and remained near <u>70% for the next six decades</u>, before beginning a steady decline around the turn of the 21<sup>st</sup> century. **Today it is at 43%**.

• The decline in church membership is primarily a function of the increasing number of <u>Americans who express no religious preference</u>. Over the past two decades, the percentage of Americans who do not identify with any religion has grown from **8%** in <u>1998-2000</u> to **22%** in <u>2021</u>.

• With Covid, we need to understand that about <u>20 percent</u> of attendees will not return. Church leaders are sharing that <u>one out of five</u> of the pre-COVID attendees will not return.

# Trends developing....

- The majority of "Attenders" may no longer be in the room.
- Growing churches will shift their focus from gathering to connecting.
- Pastors and church leaders will try to fill worship centers while others focus on fulfilling the "Mission."
- Growing churches will see the **internet** and their **buildings** differently.
- Content alone won't cut it. Community and connection will.
- Generational differences will become clearer than ever.
- Unchurched people are not looking for an echo of the culture, they are seeking an alternative to it. The future church will consist of Christians who look, live and sound much more like Jesus than the political candidate of their choice.
- We need spiritual leaders who will find tomorrow's solutions when most leaders can only see today's problem.

As is often in culture, the leaders you criticize today will be the
