John 21:1-22 NLT

Later, Jesus appeared again to the disciples beside the Sea of Galilee. This is how it happened. Several of the disciples were there—Simon Peter, Thomas (nicknamed the Twin), Nathanael from Cana in Galilee, the sons of Zebedee, and two other disciples.

Introductory Statement

Jesus had been resurrected, they had seen him, they are excited about it, but they were not sure about what was next in their lives. They needed a resurrection of purpose. Sometimes you need a resurrection of purpose because you are in a place of discouragement, and you are not sure how God is using you or what you are supposed to be doing. 
