### Closing:

Your mission has eternal consequences. Your mission involves risks and sacrifices. It requires time, effort, money, and maybe even your privacy. But if you miss it, or if you fail to accept it, you are wasting your life. If you want to be blessed in amazing ways, you must care about what God cares about—and God wants His lost children found.

In the next year, approximately 54 million people in the world will die, many of them never having heard the Good News about Jesus Christ.

The test to know if your mission is completed is this: Are you still alive? If so, God still has a mission for you. Whatever you do, don't miss out on your life mission.
